Angela has been seizure free since the day of her surgery. The constricting sensations that she had in her throat right after the surgery have passed and assumed that they were indeed from residual blood left on her brain from the surgery. Her tests and examination went very well; so well in fact, that they have moved her follow-up visit from this coming October to next May/June. This was such music to our ears and such a wonderful surprise from the Lord! “

Our plan now is to put Angela in school for the year have her evaluated at the end of that time. If she continues to progress well and there are no other complications with seizure activity at that time, we will begin the process to head back to Turkey! At that time, we will again write for grants to help financing the Battered Women's Center ministry in Turkey. “Give thanks to the Lord for He is good. His love endures forever,” (Ps 136:1).

As you know, we have been praying about where the Lord wants us to minister while stateside and it seems that He has answered our prayers. We will be staying on full-support with Charstar while Joe has the opportunity to work with Montana Bible College to put together a formal program for those desiring to major in “Cross-Cultural Ministry.” This is a real answer to prayer, as we are able to share our passion for furthering the Kingdom with young people and it allows us to stay in Bozeman with our boys who are in school. We are excited that through this program we will be able to funnel them through Charstar and also recruit these quality individuals to help with our ministry in Turkey. Joe will also be teaching an “Introduction to Islam” class at the college this Fall.

Jacob and Joshua continue to grow into fine young men of God. Jacob is entering into his second year at MSU-Bozeman and Joshua will be starting his senior year at Heritage Christian School. He is hoping to go to MSU for college and major in Engineering.

We look forward to the 2015/16 school year being sweetly normal!
